Shotgun Seat Rules & Boundaries

- 1. The driver controls this car and is responsible for it's safety.
 - a. Changing the driving or ambient conditions without proper notice is a hazard and annoying.
 - i. Driver's Father promised him, that when he grew up and paid for a car, gas, insurance, then he could control the air conditioning, radio, select the route, etc.
 - (1) Since you are riding for Free be quiet and say thanks for the ride.
 - (2) If you do not like it, then let's take your car, you drive and pay for the gas.
- 2. Do not give the driver any directions what so ever, unless specifically asked.
 - a. If it's an emergency, press the 4 way flasher and then you may give a verbal warning.
 - b. This includes:
 - i. Finding a parking space.
 - ii. General non specific complaints about traffic.
 - iii. Other drivers
 - iv. Immigration problems related to driving.
 - c. Do not ask anyone for directions.
 - i. The driver does not recall ever being lost. If we get lost or take 10 minutes longer to get somewhere, it must be G-d's will.

- 3. The only controls that you may touch without permission are:
 - a. Your
 - i. seat belt
 - ii. Visor
 - iii. Seat Adjustments
 - iv. Map Light & Thomas Brothers Map in door pocket
 - v. Right Air Vent & Right Middle Air Vent
 - b. 4 way flasher in 911 situation
- 4. If you have a need for more or less air conditioning, heat, the window open, you may ask the driver to adjust them, but you may not touch them under any circumstances.
- 5. Radio will be adjusted only by the driver.
 - a. Upon permission, you may touch the presents or scan button.
 - i. Permission is for the specific trip only. It does not apply to future trips.
- 6. This is a 5 speed on the floor car.
 - a. Driver needs the entire arm console for proper shifting. If you want to use a drink holder, there are two in the back seat, where you will be much more comfortable.
