## Psychological Services: Billing Codes and Reimbursement Rates



This section lists the CPT codes and maximum allowances for psychological services. Refer to the *Psychological Services* section in this manual for policy information. Reimbursement will be made at the provider's usual charge to the general public, not to exceed the following maximum allowances (*California Code of Regulations* [CCR], Title 22, Section 51505.3).

## Psychotherapy

The following services may be provided by a psychologist, Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW), Licensed Professional Clinical Counselor (LPCC) or Marriage and Family Therapist (MFT) and are reimbursable as follows:

Associate marriage and family therapists, associate professional clinical counselors, associate clinical social workers and psychology assistants may render psychotherapy services under the direct supervision of a licensed mental health professional in accordance with applicable state laws. The claim must list the associate or assistant's name in the *Additional Claim Information* field (Box 19) or in an attachment, along with the supervising clinician's National Provider Identifier number as the "billing provider."
