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Mental Health and Homeless Outreach for Harbor Area

- 1.) If the individual is experiencing a psychiatric episode and danger to self or to others please call the **DMH 24/7 ACCESS hotline (800 854-7771)** and DMH Psychiatric Mobile Response Team (PMRT) or System wide Mental Assessment Response Team (SMART) may be dispatched to the location depending on the individual's behavior at the time of call.
- 2.) If you suspect that a homeless individual is in need of mental health services and outreach please contact the **DMH Mobile Triage Senate Bill 82 (SB 82)** Team Lisa Powell, Mental Health Supervisor at 562 435-3037 or Juan Velazquez 213 806-9852. Provide location and physical description of individual.
- 3.) If homeless individual is frequently interacting with law enforcement and/or has multiple hospitalizations please call the DMH Assisted Outpatient Treatment **(AOT) Laura's Law** Program Malik Tate, Mental Health Supervisor 213 738-2440. Court ordered Field Specialized Program (FSP) may be referred to Department 95.
- 4.) If homeless individual declares to be a veteran *and agrees to mental health services*, please refer to the DMH Veteran and Loved Ones Recover (**VALOR**) Team Supervisor, Chris Tower 213 763-0323. Special housing vouchers are available for confirmed veterans interested in receiving mental health services.
- 5.) If the homeless individual declares to be a veteran and is *not interested in mental health services*, please contact the Veteran Administration (**VA**) Homeless Outreach team Crystal at 424 215-3502.
- 6.) Los Angeles Homeless Services Authority (**LAHSA**) has a Winter Shelter Program where homeless individuals are picked up and transported to a shelter. Homeless individual needs to be at Channel Street Park and Ride - 110 Underpass & Channel Street in San Pedro by 4:15pm. This program runs from November 1, 2015 through March 31, 2016. - 7.) If the individual is trespassing or breaking the law please contact designated Sr. Lead Officer or the **LAPD Quality of Life Unit**, Officers Lopez and Rubright at Harbor Division 310 869-2138 or 310 726-7920.
- 8.) Individuals needing immediate psychiatric evaluation and/or medication should be directed to **La Casa Urgent Care Clinic** located at 6060 Paramount Blvd., in Long Beach (562 634-9535.)
- 9.) **San Pedro Mental Health Center** is an *adult outpatient* mental health clinic. Walk in hours are Monday through Friday from 8am to 4pm to meet with "On Call Worker." Additional information can be provided by Maria Salas at 310 519-6100.
- 10.) **The Guidance Center** is a *juvenile* (18 and under) outpatient mental health clinic. Please call for additional information and walk-in hours 310 833-3571.
